Philip doubled as the hands of Michael Douglas in "Behind the Candelabra," Steven Soderbergh's 2013 HBO movie about Liberace. Spencer was UNLV's Liberace Scholar, winner of the Liberace Piano Competition, and served as artistic director at the Liberace Museum where he performed in the show "Liberace and Me."

Born on May 16, 1919, Liberace was a child prodigy who rose to international fame and enjoyed a four-decade career consisting of concerts, recordings, TV, movies, international tours, and showroom residencies in Las Vegas.
